RULES:

1. **ALL 4-H MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR ASTM/SEI APPROVED HELMETS IN ALL 4-H MOUNTED/DRIVING ACTIVITIES (EXHIBITING, PRACTICING, OR WARMING UP.)**
2. Exhibitors will read General Rules, Livestock Rules, 4-H Horse Policy, FFA Rules and Health Regulations before filling out entry forms.
3. All 4-H and FFA horses must be stalled on the fairgrounds by 8 PM Wednesday to be eligible for exhibit and competition. 4-H horse clubs and FFA chapters will have barn priority.
4. No colts or stallions allowed in 4-H.
5. Divisions 1-3 open to Lincoln County 4-H club members and FFA chapters only.
6. **NO HORSES ON MIDWAY.** Forfeiture of premium money if horses are on the midway.
7. Tack boxes are not permitted in main aisles of barns.
8. Do not saddle horses in the aisles or in the stalls. Do NOT tie horses in the stall or aisles. Do NOT leave horses saddled in stalls.
9. Lead horses from barns to holding areas and arenas.
10. Hang water and/or grain buckets in stall.
11. No hay nets/grain pans in stalls after 8 PM.
12. Dump manure only where posted.
13. Divisions 4-7 stallions/jacks must be shown only by adults, 18 and over.
14. Open class horses may be brought in anytime up to show time.

15. It is the responsibility of the open exhibitor bringing a stallion to the fair for exhibition to provide facilities for the care of the stallion, and to assume all responsibility of the same. No stallions will be stalled in the horse barn

or pens

16. Open horses will be stalled on a first-come, first-served basis, AFTER 4-H and FFA horses are stalled.

17. Open horses stalled in the barn or pens will post stall cards stating: "Open Horse" and **will keep stalls clean.**

18. **NO SHAVINGS WILL BE USED IN THE OUTSIDE LOWER PENS.**

RULES:

1. Exhibitors must read the General and Livestock Rules, and the Health Requirements before filling out entry form.
2. All birds must be identified according to breed and color on the entry form.
3. Birds in a trio or pen cannot be shown as singles.
4. For the purpose of this exhibition, the terms "cock" and "hen" shall mean birds hatched previous to current year, "cockerel" and "pullet" shall mean birds hatched in the current year.
5. A bird which is not physically fit/properly groomed shall NOT be shown or displayed. Diseased or unsightly birds will be removed from the show room. At the discretion of the General Livestock Superintendent or Barn Superintendent, an exhibit can be excluded from showing if the animal is not bitted or properly prepared for exhibiting at the Fair. All birds must be fully feathered and groomed for the Fair. Any birds not meeting this specification will be refused.
6. Birds must be in their cages by 9 PM Wednesday.
7. We provide dishes--bring your own feed.
8. Please bring decorations for your area, plus an educational poster. See Department 2.
9. Each exhibitor MUST be there for 1-2 hours of barn duty each day.
10. Your birds MUST be fed and watered by 8 AM daily and clean under your cages.
11. Fitting and Showing will be judged according to E.M. 4263
