

Welcome to the 79th Year of the Lincoln County Fair

This book includes all Fair premiums and other information for 4-H, FFA, and Open classes. Please read the instructions and rules carefully, and if you need additional help, feel free to call the Fair Office, or the Department Superintendent. The book has been organized so that all animal departments are at the front, then 4-H sections, followed by FFA sections, and then all the other departments. Each exhibitor must have his own exhibitor number; this includes clubs and organizations. All animal/fowl exhibitors must purchase a season pass before receiving their exhibitor numbers. **(Only one number per exhibitor, even if entries in 4-H, Open, and FFA.)** Entries must be filled out properly and completely before premium points can be paid. Entry forms and exhibitor numbers may be secured by stopping at the Fair Office.

The Goals of the Lincoln County Fair

Lincoln County, being the second-largest wheat-producing county in the United States and a major producer of livestock, is very definitely an agriculture based county. It is the policy of this Fair Advisory Board, and those in county government, to coordinate, organize, and present to our residents the story of our agricultural communities.
