RULES:

1. Exhibitors must read the General and Livestock Rules, and the Health Requirements before filling out entry form.
2. All birds must be identified according to breed and color on the entry form.
3. Birds in a trio or pen cannot be shown as singles.
4. For the purpose of this exhibition, the terms "cock" and "hen" shall mean birds hatched previous to current year, "cockerel" and "pullet" shall mean birds hatched in the current year.
5. A bird which is not physically fit/properly groomed shall NOT be shown or displayed. Diseased or unsightly birds will be removed from the show room. At the discretion of the General Livestock Superintendent or Barn Superintendent, an exhibit can be excluded from showing if the animal is not bitted or properly prepared for exhibiting at the Fair. All birds must be fully feathered and groomed for the Fair. Any birds not meeting this specification will be refused.
6. Birds must be in their cages by 9 PM Wednesday.
7. We provide dishes--bring your own feed.
8. Please bring decorations for your area, plus an educational poster. See Department 2.
9. Each exhibitor MUST be there for 1-2 hours of barn duty each day.
10. Your birds MUST be fed and watered by 8 AM daily and clean under your cages.
11. Fitting and Showing will be judged according to E.M. 4263

****ENTRY FEES \$ 1.00 A HEAD****

RULES:

1. Exhibitors should read all general rules, livestock rules, and health regulations before filling out entry form.
2. Rabbits or cavies suffering from disease, sickness, or ear canker will not be accepted.
3. List breed, color, age, sex, and ear number on the entry form.
4. All rabbits should have a tattoo in the left ear before Wednesday. A permanent marker may be used.
5. Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries per section/lot. All exhibitors must own the animals.
6. No substitutions except in the same breed, section, and lot.
7. Rabbits and cavies will be accepted from 3:30 PM Wednesday. No rabbits or cavies are to be placed in cages until they have been checked in.
8. All rabbit and cavy exhibitors must display an educational poster.
9. Judging schedules will be posted in the barn on Wednesday night.
10. No carrying cages left in the barn during the fair. All food must be in sealed containers.
11. All exhibitors and/or their parents will be given barn duty times during the fair.
12. In the event the number of exhibitors exceeds the space available, exhibitors will be notified on an individual basis as to when to bring their animal to be judged.
13. No sales or trades and no breeding will be allowed in the show area. Selling of any type is not permitted in the exhibit area.
14. No animal is to be removed from its cage or taken from the barn without the superintendent's permission.
15. An animal that becomes ill must be removed from the exhibit area and taken home, if possible.
16. Rabbit or cavy used for fitting & showing must be entered in breed class.
17. All entries must be at least 8 weeks old, except doe and litter, which must be at least 6 weeks old.
