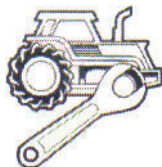

### Ode To A Volunteer

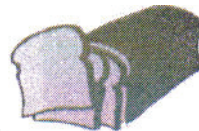
Many will be shocked to find,
