RULES:

1. **NEW---** six entries will be allowed per exhibitor in any one lot/section, except where otherwise specified.
2. Exhibits must be the recent, original work of the exhibitor and not have been entered before. Must not be a copy of original.
3. Oil paintings must be simply framed. Drawings and printings on paper must be matted, fixed or protected, and framed under glass as is fitting for the media.
3. All work must be **READY FOR HANGING**, with **WIRE** or sturdy cord firmly attached, and **NOT** taped to art work. No saw tooth hangers on heavy entries.
4. Maximum size is 28" x 36" for convenience of exhibiting.
5. Some judging points: neatness, visual appeal, overall quality, withstands handling, suitability of materials. Anything not meeting above standards will be for showing only, and **at the discretion of the superintendent.**
6. Work is entered at your own risk, although normal care will be taken to safeguard your work.
7. If there is room, we are glad to have the non-judged entries for display only.

RULES:

See General Fair Rules in front section of this book.

1. Floral building will open to the public on Thursday.
2. All horticulture entries will be received Wednesday from 6 PM - 9 PM and Thursday from 7 AM - 8:30 AM.
3. **Entries received after 8:30 AM on Thursday may be displayed, but will not be judged.**
4. Danish system of judging will be used. Each exhibit will be judged on its own merit.
5. All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor, except in the Decorative Design Division.
6. Identify or name your exhibit as specifically as possible as this is highly educational to the viewing public and a credit in judging.
7. Any entry having an IMPROPERLY FILLED IN ENTRY form will be DISQUALIFIED.
8. **It is requested that anyone bringing numerous entries, please fill out entry forms ahead of time. Forms and exhibitor numbers are available at the Fair Office.**
9. Exhibitors must furnish and be responsible for their own containers in Decorative Design Division. Accessories may be used in any Decorative Design lot.
10. No artificial flowers or foliage (e.g., plastic, silk, etc.) may be used in flower arrangements.
11. Please keep arrangements in SHOW CONDITION through end of show by replacing any wilted flowers/ foliage as necessary.
12. Department Superintendent reserves the right to remove from display any exhibit or part thereof, which is not kept up to SHOW QUALITY.
13. Fair will provide glass containers for Division 2, Section 1-21.

AWARDS:

Blue, Red, and White awards will be given in each section or lot where warranted.
If an exhibit is unworthy of award, "N/A" will show on entry tag to show entry was judged and not overlooked.
