CLASSES ELIGIBLE: 7-9

RULES:

1. One entry per each section/lot; must have been completed within the past 12 months.
2. Afghans, tablecloths, and other large items must come neatly folded (hangers are not necessary).
3. Everything must be **clean and presentable**; *superintendent and judge have the right of refusal.*
4. Judging is done on the Danish System, i.e., each item is judged against a set of standards. A full description of this system is posted in the exhibit area.
5. No premium points are paid for adult white ribbons.
6. If item is made for or by a person with special needs, so indicate on entry tag and inform superintendent.
7. We strive to handle each item carefully. If you have a special handling request, inform the superintendent.
8. Items may be entered for display only on a space available basis. Have neatly printed or typed card attached stating name and town, techniques used, why the item is of interest (historical value, etc.)
