RULES:

1. All livestock exhibitors will be required to take part in the herdsmanship contest. **NO ENTRY CARD NEEDED.**
2. Participation will be barn-to-barn oriented and mandatory for all exhibitors. Failure to comply will **VOID ANY AND ALL** awards.
3. Premium points will be awarded to winners.
4. Any exhibit not properly kept may be asked to leave the grounds.
5. **Scores will be posted daily at the sale ring.**
6. **All work is to be done by the exhibitors.** Participation by leaders and/or parents **MAY** disqualify the barn. All exhibitors must wear an exhibitor tag while working with their exhibit or exhibit area.
7. Educational posters/displays are required and will be judged only once. No certain time will be set to judge, so please keep them marked and well presentable during the whole fair.
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Award will be forfeited, and you may be asked to leave the fair if this should occur.
9. The two horse barns will be judged separately.
10. Judging daily 9 AM to 6 PM, Thursday-Saturday.



The livestock-judging contest will begin at 12:30 p.m. 4-H and FFA participants should arrive at the beef arena by 12:15 p.m. to receive judging cards and instructions. Participants are encouraged to bring a clipboard and 1-2 sharpened pencils. If you are a first time participant and would like instructions on placing animals or marking the placing cards, please arrive at 12:00 p.m.

CLASSES ELIGIBLE: 1-4, 1NP-4NP, 5-6

RULES:

1. Each contestant shall place, according to his judgment, one or more classes of hogs, sheep, and beef. Four animals shall constitute a class. Contestants will be given 8 minutes to place each class, with a 1-2 minute rotation between classes.

2. Oral reasons shall be given on the class designated. Oral reasons are required for FFA. Oral reasons are optional for 4-H but are added into the total score.

3. FFA judging will also include beef quality & yield grading.

4. 4-H & FFA members participating or exhibiting in any Lincoln County Fair activities must be registered by **August 4th** for the livestock-judging contest.

5. All other 4-H & FFA teams specifically attending the fair for the livestock judging contest are eligible for onsite registration at the beef arena on Saturday, August 26. Registration begins at 12:00 p.m. and closes at 12:15 p.m.



NO ENTRY CARDS NEEDED

RULES:

1. The Grand Champion and if unable, the Reserve Champion of the 4-H Junior, Intermediate, Senior, plus the FFA Freshman/Sophomore and Junior/Senior from the horse, beef, swine, sheep, all goats, poultry, rabbits and covies departments will automatically be entered into the Round Robin Contest.

2. **Contestants must notify either the species and the Round Robin Superintendent within 2 hours after winning their class if they CANNOT participate in the contest or they will risk forfeiting their Fitting & Showing Premiums.**

3. Large animals will include horse, beef, swine, and sheep and goats. Small animals will include rabbits, poultry, covies, and pygmy goats. There must be 5 animals exhibited in 4-H or FFA in each department to be eligible for the round Robin Contest.

4. All contestants will enter the ring with the correct species and proceed to show them for eight minutes. Then they will rotate to the next species and show it for the allotted time. This will continue until each contestant has shown each species.
