WASHINGTON STATE QUILTERS AWARD

The Washington State Quilters guild of Spokane, Washington will be awarding a cash prize of \$20.00 and ribbon to the first place winner and one additional ribbon for the second place winner.

Quilts of any size, crib quilts or wall hangings in the Adult Open Division that show best work in construction, use of color and design and application of hand quilting or machine quilting stitches are eligible for this award. Whole cloth quilts are also included. All quilts must be owned by the exhibitor. All quilts must be pieced/appliqued by the exhibitor and WSQ is allowing quilts that have been machine or hand quilted by others to be eligible for this award. A quilt that is entered with all work completed by the exhibitor should be given special consideration for this award.

INLAND NORTHWEST MACHINE QUILTERS AWARD

Inland Northwest Machine Quilters guild of Spokane, Washington will be awarding one Best of Show Machine Quilting Ribbon with a \$20 cash award and one Honorable Mention Ribbon to the Machine Quilters. Quilts of any size or style in the Adult Open Division that is machine quilted, either professionally or by the quilt maker, are eligible for the award. The awards are to be presented to the Machine Quilter whom may or may not be the owner of the quilt.

RULES:

- 1. Up to three entries per Division. Division 4, 8 & 12 may have groups of items (table runner and placemats for example ) count as one item. Please indicate length and width of each quilt on the entry form so that we may plan the show layout. Paperwork for quilts that are received in the Fair Office by August 4th, 2017 will have the quilts shown in full. Quilts entered after that date or on drop off day will have the quilts hung on an as-space-available basis, and may be hung in rotation with other late entries or folded display. Quilts must be received by 5:00PM on August 23rd to allow for judging. All quilts will be judged. You are welcome to come watch the judging.
2. Articles must be the work of the exhibitor.
3. All items must have three layers: A top, batting and a bottom and the layers must be held together. "False Backs" are not allowed. Pack each quilt separately in a see thru, non-returnable plastic bag with the entry tag visible.
4. No premium points are paid for adult white ribbons.
5. Measurements referenced in each division refers to the perimeter of each quilt. Please note the length and width of each quilt on the entry form.
