

The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Fairboard was called to order by President Bob Brooks, with 9 members present. The minutes of the December meeting were read and approved as read.

Old business discussed was the projects that were going to be done and submitted to the state for matching money. The Fair has \$3500 to \$4000. to be matched this year. Projects that are going to be looked into are Lighting in the 4-H and Flower buildings, an addition to the north restrooms, and a new building, which would be under a two year project. A motion was made and seconded to get estimates on these three projects. Motion carried.

Also included in the old business were the changes for the 1984 Premium Book. There were changes in the horse division, the record book division, the goat division, the livestock rules, the grains grasses and weeds division, the fruit and vegetable division, and it was brought to our attention that some things are hard to find, so there needs to be more referrals made in these areas. There were also changes made in the sheep division. The Spring Fairboard wanted to know the charge for renting the grounds for the Spring Fair, which is held in April. A motion was made and seconded to charge them \$2.00 plus clean-up for the rental of the grounds for the Spring fair. Motion carried.

The contract for Phillip Brown was explained to the board. It was a general consensus of the board to give the contract to Phillip, for examination, and see what happens.


