

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR ADVISORY BOARD
MAY 20, 1994

The meeting was called to order by President Bob Jones. Board members present were Amy Schroeder, Ron and Gail Heide, Karen Jones, Gerry Stiles, Orville Widmer, Anne Fillion, Celeste Sterrett, Jon Overmyer and guests Lydia Widmer, Bob Kissler, Eddie Berry and Daneen Guerin.

The meeting was opened with a discussion about a Royalty problem. The Board then went into Executive Session. Two girls from Sprague were interviewed separately and Robin Mather was chosen to represent Sprague.

Before Horse Camp the stalls in the Horse Barn 2 need to be put together. The Moon Light Riders fixed the wash racks and Scott and Debbie Hutsell donated 8 rubber mats.

Gerry showed plans for a new announcer's stand and rodeo office behind the bucking shoots.
