In the past, Lincoln County Fair has been advertised as a day fair. John Wagner moved thatit be changed to a day fair (to include sunday) It was futher suggested by Fred Springer that the Board consider having a Community Church services on that sunday at the Fairgrounds There was much discussion on the changing of the dates and it failed, than John W. moved for the dates to be the 2I, 22, 23rd, and it failed, than John W. moved for the 22, 23, 24th of August, ballots were passed out, there were I3 NO's I2YES Bob M. moved to reconsider the first vote for 22, 23, &24.

The dates that were chosen were the 22, 23, and 24th of August. Votes were 19 yeses & 5nos Positions opened for Presidency and vice President.

Bob O'Neil meminated John W. for the President, and also moved that nominationa cease, Seconded by Bob Martin.

Fred Springer moved that Rezeau Plotts be Vice President, it was seconded.
