

The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Fair Board was held at the Washington Water Power Auditorium on April 21, 1982. Donna Lindbloom, Tom Watters, Tom Freee, Orville Widmar, Joe Reichlin, Cecil Crossen, Ron Ensor and Dennis Herdrick were present.

Roger Roberts for the State Fair Assoc. was a guest. He gave an interesting presentation about fairs and the difference in color coordination.

John Wagner and Mike Booker were not present so the board elected Tom Watters as the President Pro-tem, The minutes were read and there were corrections. Minutes are corrected and approved as corrected.

Motion was made and seconded to accept the actions taken at the special meeting held April 7, 1982. Motion carried.

Motion was made and seconded to pay the April bills presented. Motion carried.

Committee reports were given by the board members who were present.

A motion was made and seconded to charge \$12.00 for camper space rental for 3 days during the fair. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded for the theme for the 1982 fair to be "Let's All Show Our Pride!" Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded for the admissions this year for the fair be as follows: Adults \$2.00, teens and senior citizens \$1.50, 12-6 \$1.00, and under 6 free. 4-H and FFA \$1.00 for the entire fair, and work passes \$1.00 per day. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded for the front gate to be open from 8 AM - 9PM with the time for the back gate to be open from 6 AM to 9 PM. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to charge 15% of gross to commercial concession booths and 15% of net to non-profit concession booths, Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to charge \$1.00 for the use of the grounds including the P A System with the amendment that grounds are left in as good or better condition to offset the \$1.00 charge for the Spring Fair. Motion Carried.

\* A motion was made and seconded to order 1 box of wrist bands for the use during the fair. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded giving members the permission to set tiles in the midway. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to remove the asphalt around the flag pole area and plant grass. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to hold meetings 2 times a month thru September lasting 2 to 2½ hours in length and cut off. They will be held the first and third Wednesdays of each month calling the first meeting a special meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to charge the May 8th horse show \$25.00 for the use of anything they want to use. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded to continue with the project of the horse barn, with any ~~being~~ being payable to the commissioners. Motion Carried.

Larry Lindbloom also told us that the Food Bank plans were back on again. The commissioners have told them they have a space available to them if they get there things organized enough to let us know everything we need to know,


John Wagner's letter of resignation was read. A motion was made and seconded to accept John's resignation as president and a member of the Lincoln County Fair Board. Motion carried.


A motion was made and seconded to table any action to be taken about the vacant presidents or members seat until the next regular meeting. Motion carried.
