A motion was made and seconded to accept the points for herdsmanship, Motion carried.

Dwight Hall from Moses Lake, has been contacted for herdsmanship judge. He will be the only judge and have all say so as to the winners of herdsmanship.

The secretary has typed a letter to all 4-H leaders concerning herdsmanshop and wristbands as their passes for the fair. A motion was made and seconded to send the letter to the 4-H leaders. Motion carried.

The Grange Master, Gorden Peterson, was concerned about the Grange Program being on Friday night the same time as the Draft Horse Pull. They felt that the Pull was takong some of there supporters away, and there is also a football game at the school that night, which aldo detracts form there attendance. It was his wishes that we have the Grange Program changed to Tharday night. After some discussion, A motion was made and seconded to change the Grange Program to Thrusday night. Motion carried.

Tom Platt the area extention agent was present, he had Virginia Wood, the new area Hone Ec. Extension agent along to meet the board. He walso brought to attention that we needed another sheep stand to complete the set.

Denis has arranged for some show cases for the 4-H building. He has also aquired some tiered shelves for the Fruit and Vegetables.


