DECEMBER 13, 1995

The meeting was called to order by President Overmyer. Minutes of the last meeting were approved.

In attendance were Josie, Karen, Orville, Anne, Lydia and Howard.

Entertainment secured so far is: Monarch Mountain Boys-Friday and Saturday-\$1200.00, OMSI-4 days, we will provide motel and meals-\$2200.00, Blacksmith-3 days-\$1275.00 plus camping space. Karen-You did great!!!

A letter from the Goat Supt. has been received telling us she will need at least 17 more pens for the next Fair. The FFA advisor in Odessa has volunteered his group to build these pens. They will have \$350.00 to buy material to build the pens. The Rabbit Dept. will move back to their original building which has been housing the Dogs. This will make more room for the goats in their barn.

Karen is writing a letter to the Commissioners asking permission to serve alcohol on the Fairgrounds in a designated area.
