

The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Fairboard was called to order by President Bob Brooks. The minutes were read, and approved as read. The bills were presented in the amount of \$4,776.92. A motion was made and seconded to pay the bills. Motion carried.

The secretary was informed of some bills that would be coming in for the horse barn and the tractor pull sled. Gene Stuckle needs a sheet of steel 10 x 8 and 3/8 inch thick. Dennis said he would look into a place in Coulee Dam area that might have some used.

The matter of the grounds keeper was brought up again. It seems that the work is still not being done after he was put on a 3 week probation. A motion was made and seconded to look for a replacement for the position. Motion carried. An ad is to be put in the local papers for a 2 week period of time advertising a part time opening at the fairgrounds for groundskeeper. The board will meet and interview the applicant on July 6th at 7:00 at the Fairgrounds. During the meeting Dave Wheeler of Wilbur called to inform the board that he was resigning. A motion was made and seconded to accept his resignation. Motion carried.

It was suggested that we put a thank you in the paper thanking Mike Booker for everything he has done for the Fair.


The rules for the tractor pull are in the works. This tractor pull will be open to stock tractors only, no modified tractors allowed.

The 4-H Youth council asked to store their dunk tank at the Fairgrounds year around. A motion was made and seconded to charge them \$5.00 per year for the storage area for their dunk tank. Motion carried.

Being no further business the meeting was adjourned until July 20th, 1983 at 8:00 p.m.
