MARCH 15, 1995

The meeting was called to order and minutes of the last meeting were approved.

In attendance were Bob and Karen Jones, Orville Widmer, Ron and Gail Heide, Amy Schroeder, Anne Fillion, Lydia Widmer, Howard Stormo, Eddie Berry and Josie Breshears.

First order of business was picking a theme for the 1995 Fair. Suggestions were given and narrowed down to 3 and a vote was taken and the theme will be DENIM AND LACE.

A motion was made and passed that entertainment in the future will require a decision from 3 Board members before a contract can be signed.

Moving of the hamburger stand was discussed. Hopefully it can be moved and put 6 to 8 feet from the north side of the Quonset Hut.

Two quotes for the Premium Book were read and it was awarded to the Wilbur Register for \$1890.00 for 88 pages.

The Arena Improvement audit was discussed by the audit committee and the other Board members would like to see the books also. Secretary will send them all a copy.

Eddie gave a report on Royalty and will be running an ad listing the requirements.

Gail reported that Julie will hold the Fiddlers Contest on Sunday this year. Ideas on how to control the Fiddlers gate were discussed.

Josie made the Board aware that the private Junior Rodeo held last year did not have an ambulance on the grounds both days. The ambulance was there on Saturday but were told they were not needed on Sunday because they had their own EMT's, some from Idaho. Later on Sunday, the ambulance was called for an injured person. The ambulance crew will gladly be on the grounds for a donation and 3 weeks notice as to when they are needed. Washington State certified EMT's should be on the grounds with the ambulance during an event. This requirement should be put on the contract.
