A QUESTION WAS RAISED ABOUT REIMBURSEMENT TO MARK BLUMHAGEN TO GET MORE RIDES IN HERE OR PAYING SOME ENTERTAINMENT. LARRY MOVED AND FRED SECONCED THAT DONNA MAKE THAT CHOICE DEPENDING ON WHAT WE COULD DO WITH MARK. THE MOTION SECONDED BY BOB MARTIN AND CARRIED.

IT WAS MOVED BY LARRY THAT THE HORSE BARN BE PUT AS CLOSE TO THE WASH RECK AS POSSIBLE ON THE EAST AND NOT PROTRUDE ANY FURTHER WEST THAT THE LINE OF THE FRONT OF THE POULTRY BUKLDING. JOHN DEIFE SECONDED AND MOTION CARRIED.
