

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD MINUTES

November 2, 2007

Gerry began the meeting at 6:45 PM. Connie, Stephanie & Mike Stauffer, Gretchen & Emma Wiedmer, Lydia, Colleen & Emily Houger, Gerry and Sharon were in attendance.

There was much discussion about royalty budget. We had allocated \$800.00 in the past. The crown for the queen is \$250.00, princess is \$175.00. Sashes were \$175.00 for the 4 girls. The belt buckles are anywhere from \$35.00 and up.

Gretchen moved that the LC Fair sponsor \$1100.00 of the royalty's budget. Since there were not enough for a quorum, it will have to be tabled until the next meeting.

Connie reported that there will be a royalty scrapbook at the end of the girls reign.

It was discussed that the royalty tryouts be moved to accommodate the girls helping at the chicken dinner.

The royalty will be crowned by the queen after dismounting from their horse.

Sharon will be writing a letter to Sarah Dahlquist to see if she still wants to be involved.

The royalty colors chosen are pink, silver and black. Business cards were brought up.

Lydia was upset about banners and ribbons that were ordered for the herdsmanship winners. Sharon or Lydia were not aware of specific ones ordered for that department.

The water is off.

Fred Bell traced the water leak. It is in the vicinity of the old restrooms (our new garden shed). In the spring we will use a backhoe and dig up the line and block it off.

Sharon read Jill Swannack's letter as the 4H Council President. Jill recommended that the premium book go out earlier next year.

Sharon reported boat/RV storage usually brings in about \$12,000-\$13,000 per year.

The arena gate is broken.

4H groups renting the arena will need to make a reservation & pay for it on the same day. There was no action taken on this because lack of a quorum.

Anyone who wants water on the arena will need to pay \$25.00 per load.

Premium points will be \$0.16 per point.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 PM.
