SEPTEMBER 18, 1998**

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDENT OVERMYER. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND APPROVED.

IN ATTENDANCE WERE MAGGIE, BILL, ANNE, JOSIE AND LYDIA.

TJ CAROTHERS INQUIRED ABOUT USING THE 4-H KITCHEN FOR HIS GROUP TO GET THEM USE TO THE AREA TO DO DEMO'S AT THE NEXT FAIR. APPROVAL WAS GIVEN.

THE SALMON BBQ SERVED 267 AND MADE \$1144.00 PROFIT.

JON APPOINTED JOSIE TO BE THE VOTING DELEGATE AT THE STATE CONVENTION.

AMY SCHROEDER HAS GIVEN HER RESIGNATION EFFECT TODAY FROM THE FAIR BOARD DUE TO HEALTH PROBLEMS. WE NOW HAVE 7 BOARD MEMBERS.

THE DATES FOR THE 1999 FAIR WERE SET FOR AUGUST 26-29.

THE GATE FOR THE 1998 FAIR WAS 5900, AN INCREASE FROM LAST YEAR'S 5100. WE HAD 1086 MORE EXHIBITS AND 69 MORE EXHIBITORS THAN 1997, PAID .25 A POINT AND PAID \$21,586.25 FOR PREMIUM POINTS.
