LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD MINUTES

March 16, 1964

The meeting was called to order by President McKay at 1:45 p.m., March 16, 1964, in the Extension office in Davenport.

Members present: Mim McKay, Laurabelle Kunz, Dorothea Johnson, Ella Scheibner, Glenn Morrison, Richard Harding, Katie Raugust and Joe Linstrum

Also present: Lloyd McLain, Harold Jenkins and Rose Jenkins

Lloyd McLain met with the Board to discuss digging the ditch for the water main on the Fair grounds. Joe Linstrum reported we have to advertise for bids as it is over \$500.00. We will need 8" pipe to the end of the steel building (the booth building), then 6" pipe to the NE corner of the new steel building, where the Lions clubs have had their diving board. 700' of 8" pipe is needed and 300' of 6" pipe. The price for 6" pipe is \$1.62 per foot and \$2.05 for the 8" steel, without fittings. Fire hydrants are \$130.00 each. The total cost will be approximately \$2,600.00 with steel pipe; about \$3,000.00 with cast iron. Motion made by Dorothea Johnson that we empower the grounds committee and the committee that meets with the Commissioners, to act for the Fair Board in this matter. Seconded by Laurabelle Kunz. Carried. This committee consists of Joe Linstrum, Glenn Morrison, Richard Harding and James McKay.

It was reported Herman Reinbold will be chairman of the dance committee.

Chester Long will be Poultry and Rabbit superintendent.

Letter from the Fair Association stating the District meeting will be Saturday, March 21, 1964, at 10:00 am in the Ceour d'Alene Hotel. There will be a discussion of the changes in the Fair report.

It was reported that we need better display areas for the sewing. Katie Raugust and Verna Johns and Virginia Hutsell to be charge of arranging a better display area.
