

seconded by Donna Christianson. Carried. Clarence will take charge of this.


Larry Whiteside given authority to organize parade as he chooses to. The Fair Board will stand behind his decisions.

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD MINUTES

August 9, 1971

The meeting of the Lincoln County Fair Board was called to order by President R. M. Plotts, Monday, August 9, 1971 at 8:30 p.m., in the Extension Office in Davenport.

Minutes of the July 7 and July 12 meetings were read and approved.

Mrs. Madden of Parloand Patio Club met with the Board in regard to their serving Tacos and Chili from 12:00 to 4:00 p.m. Saturday at the Fair. Some discussion whether this would conflict with either the Lions Club concession or the Hamburger concession. Felt it would be something different. Motion made by Donna Christianson that the Parlor and Patio Club be allowed to serve Facos and Chili on Saturday from noon until 4:00 p.m. Seconded by Mr. McKay. Carried. Need to know where stand could be located so they can have electricity. Board will look into the electricity problem for them.

Mr. Brown brought up the need to have demonstrations where they could be more visible. Last year it was in 4-H building and space was quite limited for viewing public. Suggested use of old pop stand. Move it where it is wanted and have it moved there.

September 20 suggested as night to have Fair evaluation meeting.

The Public Address System has been removed and it was found obsolete and

impossible to get parts. Suggested we ask VFW what they plan on using for rodeo.

Further discussion was held on compiling superintendent's notebook. Each superintendent to compile such a book. Motion made by Donna Christianson that Mr. Brown be authorized to purchase these notebooks and fillers for Fair and pay for them. Seconded by Mr. McKay. Carried.

Mr. Brown reported that Sharon Ames would like to purchase some materials to fix up the 4-H building. This permission was granted.

Secretary Verna Johns read budget she had submitted and compiled for 1972. She also read list of expenditures through July 31, 1971. Reported fencing contract was paid August 2, 1971 to Ralph's Fencing Company in the amount of \$4,971.75. The Fair Board approved the 1972 preliminary budget prepared by the Secretary and accepted her Treasurer's report.

Bea Teel reported all utensils have been received for the kitchen; have been marked Lincoln County Fair and are at the Fair Building. Also reported Marlene Overmyer of Reardan will take charge of the Kiddie's Parade.

Chuck Plumb said he would arrange a Fly-Over during the Parade of jet planes. He is to contact Larry Whiteside to make arrangements for this.


Chuck Plumb would like to take pictures of exhibitors and exhibits at the Fair and then have them for sale.
