

The following changes were recommended for the Cattle and Sheep Division of the premium list. (1.) Market Steer to be 800 pounds (page 16 - VI of 1969 book. (2.) VII - Lamb must weigh 80 pounds and Hogs between 190 and 240 pounds. XIV - All underweight livestock will be shown in feeder class and sold with no support price. Sheep (E) Lot 13-Feeder lambs; Swine (F) Lot 9-Feeder pig; Beef (D) Lot 2-Bulls, calved before June 1, 1969 to September 30, 1969.

Motion made by Mike Booker and seconded by Bea Teel that these changes be accepted and so corrected in the premium book. Carried.

Lawrence Brown asked that the Cooperative Extension Service page (page 9 in 1969 book) be deleted. Consideration of this followed with much discussion centered on the Extension Office's role in the Fair. It was the concensus of the Board that to eliminate any mention of the Extension Service at all, would draw them even further from the Fair--its needs and activities. The Board voted to have this page remain in the premium book.

President McKay reported on the State Fair Convention. There is to be more money allocated among the fairs in 1970. We should have an item in the budget for advertising. In regard to percentage asked of the various concessions serving during the Fair, the Fair delegates agreed it should always be on the gross amount. In talking with other Fair delegates, Mr. McKay found the 20% we are asked to be in accord with nearly all other fairs. There was much discussion of beautification of the Fair Grounds.


Agenda for next meeting: Discussions on the following-Hog Barn, more bleachers; Hot plate elements in the new Hamburger stand.

Ed Young will see about getting an electric stove for the new refreshment stand.

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD MINUTES

February 10, 1970

The meeting of the Lincoln County Fair Board was called to order by President McKay, at 1:45 P.M., February 10, 1970 at the Extension Building in Davenport.

Present: John E. Deife, Clarence Wagner, Ed Young, R. M. Plotts, Bea Teel, Mike Booker, W. James McKay and Secretary Verna Johns

Also present: Mr. Van Lueven, Lawrence Brown

Minutes of the previous meeting were read, approved and adopted.

Mr. Van Lueven met with the Board regarding the Spokane Indian Inland Tribal Council putting on an exhibition at the Fair this Fall. Luella Gorneau, who lives in the Spokane Valley, contacted him about coming to our Fair. After considerable discussion a motion was made by Mike Booker we invite this Council exhibition to the 1970 Fair and Mrs. Gorneau and representatives of the Lions Clubs of Lincoln County meet with the Fair Board to discuss this matter. Second by John E. Deife. Carried.

Discussion of a new Hog Barn building. A Butler type MH3, size 42x90x10 could be built for a cost of \$4,813.00 with volunteer help. Extra charge would be made for the wall color-\$540.00. A building 60'x40' was the size President McKay had in mind. Motion made by Mike Booker we build a 40' X 100' X 8' open span, closed gables, colored steel building. Seconded by Ed Young. Carried.


Motion made by Bea Teel, seconded by R. M. Plotts, that premiums for Class IV in Floriculture be the same as other premiums for like entries; Blue, \$1.24; Red, \$1.00 (page 66 of 1969 premium book). Motion carried. (No premiums were listed for this class in the 1969 premium book.)

It was reported the signs formerly used to advertise the Pike Derby have been offered to the Fair if any use can be made of them. Motion made by John E. Deife, seconded by Mike Booker, we accept these signs. Carried.

Much discussion of Leslie Seimer as Maintenance man at the Fair Grounds. Numerous complaints have been received regarding trash not picked up on the Fair Grounds, signs not removed after the Fair is over, etc. Secretary instructed to ask Robert Dodge if he would be interested in this position.
