

February 19, 1986

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was as follows: The deposit of 125.17 to cover the business was made and the chaperone fund cleared. The balance must be left because the checks were not stamped with a warning to cash before a certain time.

Bills were 119.48 WWP, 23.84 Telephone, and 43.23 City of Davenport. The telephone credit will be on next month's bill. Lois has copies of all expenses and revenues for last year. A log will be started for all fair-related calls and kept by all of us making calls. From the December print-out the budgeted amount is 47,868 and there were expenses of 32,901 from 1985. There will possibly be 8 to 10 thousand to carry over to this year but there could be more expenses that Lois does not know about. Moved and seconded to approve report.

Mike Stormo asked about budgeting for the chaperone fund this year and John explained it came out of the revolving fund and that the amount last year was 350. A discussion of the need of the royalty followed and we felt we should pay for tiaras and sashes for the girls. John said we also need a sign for the royalty for parades.

Committee reports were called for. We talked about limits on concessions and entertainment costs and found that 1400 was spent last year including the salmon for the salmon feed.

Under new business we discussed the need for show rabbit hutches.

A riding mower was offered to us at 200 dollars and it was decided to purchase it.

After much discussion we decided to provide parking for RVs at the fairgrounds when people are going to the World's Fair beginning in May.

Steve discussed having dances for the kids both to provide the service and to make some money for our fair. We shall try it to see if we can make a success of regular dances.

Orville suggested we get \$5 from people for listing their names as fair supporters. This was approved.

We also discussed who is responsible for cleaning the building and could it be used for spring demonstrations on April 19? It is possible to use local inmates for the cleaning.

The next meeting will be March 19 at the Cottonwood. Meeting was adjourned.
