Old Bus: Steve Bradburn

Advertising for 1987 Prem Book - all board members were asked to collect money for ads at time of contact with persons or person/clip out old ad put on advertising sheet also any changes or correction at this time. (Board members were supplied with ad form and 1986 prem books) also push community pages (family names ) for \$5.00 .

Old Bus: Special Projects for 1987: Steve Bradburn informed board members that he dose has bids for lighting in 4-H bldg, concrete floor in sheep barn,(discussion on floor in sheep barn) Dick Douglas though that concrete was dangerous for sheep, Mike Stormo brought up sanitation for dirt floor, also present superintendent is pushing for concrete floor in barn. Steve Bradburn stated that these projects are all still in the preliminary stages we still need to get ok from state.

Bret Guelke - asked fair board members if it is possible for a student to keep an animal at fair grounds, Discussion on matter general feeling was this would be impossible due to insurance reasons.

New Bus: Jim Puls - Anna Bend Presented - Jim is asking to use the grounds on August 1, & 2, 1987 for a Jr. Rodeo also at Fair time on September 3, 1987 cow penning Sept 4, Jr Rodeo and Sept 5, over 30yrs Rodeo.

Discussion on matter, Board felt that there would be no problem with this ok. (John Overmeyer - would like to have a mule and burro play day on Saturday during the fair.) we will try to work both these in at fair time.

March 4, 1987 at 11:00 A.M. someone from the bldg committee will meet with the State Fair Assoc in Moses Lake.

April 10, and 11, 1987 at Yakima, Washington is a Superintendents meeting. (Annie to send addresses of all Board Members to Caroline Fisher so they) (receive news letter)

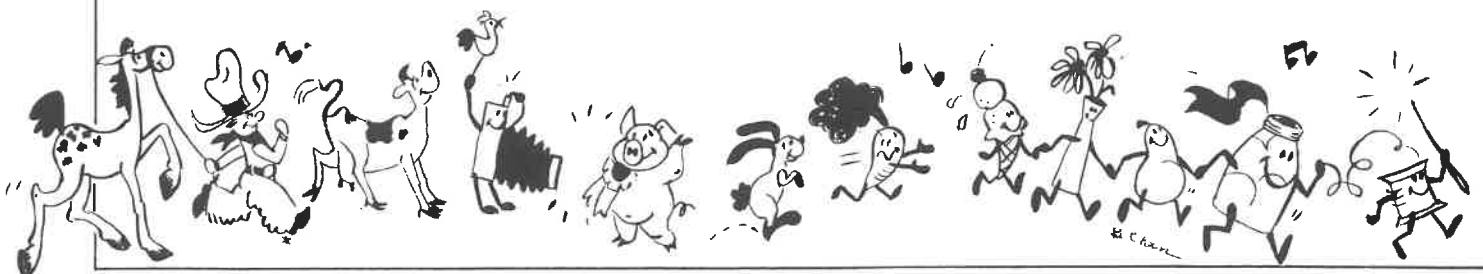
