It was decided that it would be cheaper if we could rent one on our own and put it on ourselves. Deloss suggested we get in touch with the Grange at Harrington and see what thay would do for price. Fred Springer moved that the Board give John Wagner, Donna Johnston and Deloss Rodenbough the power to make a decission on the paint and the rental of the sprayer. The motion was seconded by John Deife and motion passed.
