

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD MINUTES

May 10, 1971

The meeting of the Lincoln County Fair Board was called to order by President R. M. Plotts at 8:23 p.m., in the Extension Office in Davenport, on May 10, 1971.

Present: R. M. Plotts, Clarence Wagner, W. James McKay, Donna Christensen, Bea Teel, John E. Deife, Les Wilcox and Secretary Verna Johns.

Also present: Les Seimer, Sharon Ames

Minutes of the previous meeting read, corrected and approved.

President Plotts read reply to letter written to Roger Roberts regarding matching funds to put in new floor in main hall. Said donated labor can go towards matching money.

Discussed the printing of the book. Motion made by John E. Deife, seconded by Bea Teel, that Davenport Times publish the Fair book again this year. Carried.

Bea Teel reported on taking count of utensils at Fairgrounds. Mrs. Raugust, Mrs. Seimer, Donna Christensen and Bea counted them. The Fair needs the following: 20 more salt and pepper sets; 2 large sets of salt and pepper sets for the kitchen; 2 - 84 cup coffee makers; 1 dozen sugar bowls and 1 dozen cream pitchers; 1 dozen 3 quart or gallon coffee pitchers; 2 - 6 quart kettles with lids; 2 - 2 gallon kettles with lids.

Secretary reported on purchase of bumper stickers. Russell Chase is selling bumper stickers this year. Decision of where to purchase left to the Secretary.

Sharon Ames reported there will be judges schools in Ritzville, June 8, 1971; Wilbur, June 9, 1971 and Reardan, June 10, 1971.


Motion made to have next meeting the first Monday in June, June the 7th, as President will not be here, but at State Grange Convention June 14th our regular meeting night. Seconded and carried.


Discussion of Chaperone to assist Mrs. Deife this year. Thought it should be someone from Wilbur, Almira or Creston. Mr. McKay and Mr. Wagner to see if they can find someone.

Les Seimer told of difficulties in repairing doors on East side of main hall. The door is lower than or the same height as ground and when it rains, water backs up under the door.

Donna Christensen reported glass broke in one of cabinets in the 4-H building. Les Seimer to get new glass and put it in.
