Hulga Schmidt was present to show her pictures of the Fair. She made the comment that it was the best fair that she had ever seen. The original contract was for 60 pictures for \$]50/00 but she got carried away with the fair and took 329 but offered them to us at the same price if she could take copies of them to Germany with her. The Fair Board agreed and then viewed the pictures.

Lydia asked that the Fair provide some kind of a hitching post for the horses so they wouldn't have to be tied to the fence. More for safety than anything.

Fred moved that the Market Steers must be tagged for carcuss data before they are let out on the grounds at the fair, R. M. Plotts meceded and the motion passed.

The Bills and accounts were read and approved. R. M. Plotts moved we pay all bills presented in the amount of \$. the motion was seconded by Elmer Mann and motion passed.

A QUESTION WAS RAISED AS TO THE EXPENCE OF BLACKTOP, AND FRED MOVED THAT WE COMMISSION DELOSS TO GET AN ESTIMATE ON THE HORSE BARN FOR REMODELING. IT WAS SECONDED BY ELMER AND MOTION CARRIED.

LYDIA ASKED THAT THE FAIR BOARD CONSIDER A HORSE SHOW ON MAY 6 & 7 OF 1978. R. M. PLOTTS MOVED AND JOHN DEIFE SECONDED THAT THE SECRETARY GET CONTRACTS AND SET UP THE SHOW FOR THOSE DATES.

JOHN DEIFE MOVED THAT WE HAVE THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION ON THE 11TH DAY OF JANUARY, IT WAS SECONDED BY BOB O'NEIL AND MOTION CARRIED.

NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE MEETING ADJOURNED.
