

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD
NOVEMBER 20, 1991
MEETING MINUTES

Present: Bob & Karen Jones, Orville Widmer, Celeste Sterrett

Guests: Lydia Widmer, Howard Stormo

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM.

The minutes of the October 23, 1991 meeting were approved as read.

Bob gave the treasurer's report. Vouchers for \$310.33 have been paid. Howard has collected \$8,942.50 for trailer storage to date with and estimated \$250 more to be collected. There is \$1,245.83 left in the revolving fund. Gerry and Bob met with the commissioners on the 1992 preliminary budget, the commissioners requested we keep our budget at the 1991 level.

Orville reported the Arena Improvement Committee has purchased a mobile 'cook shack'.

Howard reported the Taco Stand and it's refrigerator are now standing after the big blow.

A motion was made and approved to review the maintenance lease on the copier from ABC Office Equipment.

The Lincoln County Wheat Growers have asked Bob if they could donate money to distribute to the winners of Grains & Grasses in exchange for free advertisement in the premium book.

Bob reported on the 1992 Committee Assignments. Celeste will help Gerry with Family Meals, at this time all others remain the same as in '91.

We again discussed the proposed advertising sign to be located on fair property. Even though the fair would earn \$300/yr it was decided not to accept the proposal because it would conflict with the Davenport Chamber sign and would do little to enhance the overall appearance of the fairgrounds.

The commissioners suggested to Bob that since so many seniors attend the fair on Friday because of the Salmon Bar-be-cue, the fair might consider initiating a reduced gate for seniors on that day. All agreed that was a good idea.
