John asked if the Haunted House advertising could be covered by EDC. Dawn will talk to Margie about what is covered be EDC in way of advertising.

John started a discussion about providing some type of entertainment during Davenport's town festival, Pioneer Days. An event that could be beneficial to the Fairgrounds and Pioneer Days. A few ideas were presented such as Bull Riders and working with the Davenport Fire Department in providing some type of concert.

Dale Haughian contacted John to determine if Dale was needed for next year's rodeo during the County Fair.
