Rules and Information:

1. All 4-H and FFA exhibitors are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets in all 4-H and FFA Mounted/Driving Activities, including exhibiting, practicing and warming up.
2. Exhibitors will read General Rules, Livestock Rules, 4-H Horse Policy, FFA Rules and Health Regulations before filing out entry forms or online with ShoWorks
3. All 4-H and FFA horses must be stalled on the fairgrounds by 8 PM Wednesday to be eligible for exhibit and competition. 4-H horse clubs and FFA chapters will have barn priority.
4. No colts or stallions allowed in 4-H.
5. No horses on Midway, forfeiture of premium money if horses are on the midway
6. Tack boxes are not permitted in main aisles of barns.
7. Do not saddle horses in the aisles or in the stalls.
8. Do not tie horses in the stall or aisles.
9. Do not leave horses saddled in stalls.
10. Lead horses from barns to holding areas and arenas.
11. Hang water and/or grain buckets in stall.
12. No hay nets/grain pans in stalls after 8 PM.
13. Dump manure only where posted.
14. No shavings will be used in the outside lower pens.
15. Clean up all areas, including wash racks.



FFA Equine Dress Code:

- ✓ All FFA equine exhibitors must abide by the WAHSET rules.
- ✓ The required uniform consists of a solid polo shirt with collar, long sleeve, rolled down to the wrist, and shirt tucked in; solid color western style pants/jeans or English breeches or jodhpurs and appropriately corresponding boots for the style of riding and tack used.
- ✓ Boots must have a definite heel.
- ✓ Exhibitors with long hair need to wear it neatly, so that their number is clearly visible.
