

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

AUGUST 2005

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by President Gerry Stiles. In attendance were Gretchen, Josie, Lydia, Lisa, Dale, Becky, Phil & Patricia.

The minutes were approved as read.

There will be an ice machine in place for the fair this year. It will be outside the small office so Sharon & Teresa will be able to collect money easier. The machines will remain locked at all times except to retrieve ice.

Gerry told us that the Blue Grass Festival paid their bill.

The Cheney Free Press is the Base paper; we will need to place ads in that paper to reach the families on base. We will also offer up to 20 tickets. Josie moved & Dale & Lisa 2nded to offer the ticket to the base.

Mike Moser and his crew put a new roof on the cat barn; he will also have a crew available to help each day of the fair around the grounds.

The barrel racers want us to reconsider our prices. We will charge the two races in July and any upcoming races, \$125.00 per date. We will charge this amount from now on, until we gather more data from other facilities about their charges.

Fire camp rates were discussed; it was decided to lower the rates to \$1000.00 flat rate for all services and will decrease as gear down begins. Phil moved to charge a flat \$1000.00 rate for all services and decrease as gear down begins. The crews have given a verbal that move out will happen on or before & no later than the 21st of August.

Norvin's will not be at the fair this year, so Huckleberry Heaven will be in the back by the arena, with the understanding that if Norvin's comes back next year that will be their spot again.

Cricket wants her same spot as last year.

Dale and Phil will paint lines for RV camping on Saturday or Sunday, Patricia will print and laminate numbers for each of the full hook-ups at least.

Most of the projects have been done by the inmates, but because fire camp is here and there are inmates from other facilities the local inmates can't be on the premise at the same time by law, so until fire camp is over the inmates will not return.

Lydia has been in the office taking calls and helping while Sharon is in the hospital, she will continue until Teresa can maybe come in. Becky has also offered to help on Monday, Tuesday and Friday (her days off.)
