## Fair Advisory Board Meeting Minutes September 15, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 6:31 PM

Brad presented the list compiled by emails from fair board members for be reviewed for the 2022 fair. This meeting will be used to go over this list in a timely one hour and thirty minutes.

Brad brought up a need for dealing with complaints, he suggested that we all have a standard answer that members will use when receiving the complaint. It was agreed by all members present that if a complaint is received the member would ask that the complaint be emailed to Dawn and she would then bring it to a formal meeting for the board/county to address.

Katie asked if we had a report from the state judge and it was stated that the state judge only comes every three years. It was also discussed that numbers for the fair would be at the next meeting as Dawn was unable to attend this meeting.

Bryce presented from Friends of the Fair. He started by introducing all the FOF members present and it was discussed that FOF would be attending the fair board meetings so we can all be on the same page. Bryce then recapped the budget from FOF for the fair.

Rodeo: Entry fees brought in \$19,990 and payouts were \$14,224, there was starting cash and paying of judges \$150 a day, timers \$125 a day, and secretary \$250 a day. The profit (need a new total) will sit in the FOF account until it is needed. We discussed the paid positions as they were mostly fair board members and it was agreed to pay the judge, timers and secretary because without fair board members we would have to pay someone to do that position. John, Teresa and Katie donated half of their earnings back to FOF, Bryce will get a check to them. The Playday brought in \$134, Pig Scramble \$315, and the Chute \$1200. The beer garden was a success Friday night \$3166, Saturday \$5134 for a total of \$8300. With paying for beer, ice, liquor license the total profit was \$4,915.83.

The rest of the meeting was spent looking at the compiled list and discussing quick possible solutions and determining if the item was a county or fair board issue. Brad has the list and the notes from that discussion.
