Division 1: Clothing & Sewn Items

Rules and Information:

1. All exhibits must have a permanently attached care label, or be accompanied by a 3x5 card containing the fiber content and care instructions.

Section 1: Small Sewn Items

- Lot 1: Clothing accessories
- Lot 2: Specialty Items, non-household
- Lot 3: Household Items
- Lot 4: Stuffed Animals

Section 2: Group Entry

- Lot 1: Clothing and Textile project or display completed by 2 or more youth

Section 3: Garments

- Lot 1: Single but separate skirt, blouse, shorts, slacks, shirt, etc
- Lot 2: Dress or Jumper
- Lot 3: Separates of 2 or more items displayed as a set
- Lot 4: Coat or Suit
- Lot 5: Evening Wear, clothing you would wear to a formal or semi-formal occasion
- Lot 6: Sleep Wear
- Lot 7: Other Items

Rules and Information:

1. May enter up to 3 items in each lot.
2. Food exhibits must be accompanied by a 3" X 5" recipe card taped to the bottom of plate.
3. All food exhibits must be on a 9-inch paper plate and enclosed in a plastic zip-locked bag.
4. Baked entries may be turned in August 24th, 6:30-8:00 pm or August 25th, 7:30-8:30 am.
5. No cream frostings or fillings.
6. Food preservation must follow the rules in the Canning Department.
