

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD MINUTES

February 12, 1969

The meeting was called to order by President McKay February 12, 1969, at 1:45 p.m., at the Extension office in Davenport.

Present: Ed Young, Mike Booker, Les Wilcox, Clarence Wagner, Bea Teel, James McKay, John E. Deife

Also present: Commissioner Harold Striegel, Paul Reilly, Margaret Barbee, Larry Brown

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

President McKay reported the Lincoln County Fair had received \$10,500.00 from Pari-Mutual funds for this year (1969).

Commissioner Striegel mentioned the need of making our plans earlier---the sooner, the better. He also suggested the Fair make a long range plan; such as a 4 or 5 year plan for major improvements so everything will not be a last minute rush.

Margaret Barbee and Paul Reilly, representing the 4-H club pop concession, met with the Board regarding having a second pop stand under the grand stands. They suggested a portable stand, having skids under it. They submitted plans for a building 6' x 8', which they felt would be large enough. It would have a 16" wide serving shelf 36" high, and an end shelf inside 18" wide, with the door to open out. The FFA has volunteered to build it. It was reported there is some plywood stored in the flower building that can be used. Mike Booker appointed to be in charge of this and will see that materials needed are available.

Mrs. Barbee asked if there were some way of silencing the noise of the girls' walking during the Dress Revue. This noise makes it difficult to hear the commentor. She suggested a running carpet and said Mrs. Lawrence Peterson knows where one is available. Mrs. Barbee volunteered to look into this and report back to the Fair Board.

Jim Puls has offered to furnish the awards for Horse Herdmanship; the first place club to receive \$5.00, and the second place club \$3.00. They will be donated by him in the name of the Reardan Saddle Tramps 4-H Horse Club. Motion we accept this sponsorship by Mike Booker, seconded by Les Wilcox. Carried. This is to be listed in Fair book.


The Big Bend Sheep Producers will present a trophy in fitting and showing to one Senior and one Junior 4-H exhibitor. This is to be listed in the Fair book.

Secretary asked to write a letter to Mrs. Robert Schultz to see if she will ask someone to serve as chaperone for the Fair Royalty this year.

Mike Booker reported he knows a family with 3 children willing to keep the Fair grounds cleaned up during the summer for \$100.00 a month.

Motion to adjourn by Les Wilcox, seconded by Bea Teel. Carried.
