

LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR BOARD MINUTES

June 11, 1969

The meeting of the Lincoln County Fair Board was called to order by President McKay, June 11, 1969, at 8:40 p. m., at the Extension office in Davenport.

Present: R. M. Plotts, Les Wilcox, Clarence Wagner, Mike Booker, James McKay

Also present: John Sawyer, Leslie Seimer

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mike Booker reported talking with County Engineer, David Davis, regarding gravel on the Fair grounds. He had also talked with the County Commissioners regarding the hiring of labor to take care of the Fair grounds during the summer for \$100.00 a month. The Commissioners had no objection to this and thought it a good idea. A motion was made by Clarence Wagner, seconded by Les Wilcox, we hire a family for a contract of \$300.00 for 90 days to clean Fair grounds starting the middle of June to the middle of September. Carried.

Secretary reported she had been contacted by the Boy Scouts Council about using the Fair grounds for a County Boy Scout exhibition October 18, 1969. Motion by Mr. Plotts, seconded by Les Wilcox, the Boy Scouts be allowed to use the Fair Grounds October 18, 1969, rent free. Carried.

John Sawyer, representing the Davenport Lions Club, met with the Board regarding the Carnival Concession. The Davenport Club has decided to go ahead with the Carnival if other clubs will continue also. Reardan and Edwall Lions clubs seem to favor dropping it since the ruling of the Attorney General regarding "games of chance", especially Bingo, their largest money maker.

Discussion of the new hamburger stand. Mr. McKay and Les Wilcox are to meet with the Commissioners June 16 in regard to calling for bid for this structure.

The Odessa Riding Club has asked for the hamburger concession for all 4 days of the Fair.

The Presbyterian Church ladies who have been serving the Salmon Barbecue feel they should have more than the \$100.00, the Fair has been paying. Motion by Les Wilcox, seconded by Mike Booker, we offer them a 60%-40% split on serving the Salmon Barbecue. Carried.

July 8, 1969

The meeting of the Lincoln County Fair Board was called to order by President McKay, July 8, 1969, at 8:30 p.m., at the Extension office in Davenport.

July 8, 1969 (con't)

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Cecil Telecty, representing the Edwall Lions Club, met with the Fair Board regarding the Carnival Concession. They are willing to continue with the Pony Ride and Snow Cone concessions. He wondered if the snow cone concession would be in the new building.

Les Wilcox reported on the meeting Mr. McKay and he had with the County Commissioners, June 16. They had to give the specifications for the new building at that time as the Notice of Call for Bid had to be published immediately.

A letter was read from the Bureau of Reclamation at Ephrata requesting a booth at the Fair and also an entry in the Parade.

Motion by Vivienne Schultz, seconded by Bea Teel, the Fair purchase rubber underpadding for carpet for Dress Revue to cost about \$40.00. Motion carried.

The Fair Board itself will be in charge of the Queen Dance, as no one or any organization could be found to take charge of it.


It was reported Cook's Masonry of Odessa was awarded the bid to build the new refreshment (formerly referred to in the minutes as hamburger stand) building. Their bid was over \$5,400.00. As we only have \$5,000.00 in our Capital Outlay, the additional costs will have to be taken from other items in the budget. This will make it tight to stay within our budget this year.

Discussion of the budget for 1970 followed. The following increases were deemed necessary to continue to operate the Fair. It was brought out that our budget has not been increased for at least the last 3 years. The Secretary is to submit these increases for the 1970 budget. Salary and Wages, \$600.00; Maintenance and Repair, \$1,000.00; Capital Outlay, \$1,000.00. Secretary also instructed to increase amount needed for advertising and Judges.

A work day is planned for Friday, July 11, 1969.
