Rules and Information:

- 1. Deadline for entries: August 11th.
- 2. The superintendent will schedule demonstration times and will notify entrants.
- All exhibitors must provide a phone number and an email address for notification of demonstration times.
- 4. The superintendent will try to work around other events.
- It is very important if you sign up for a demonstration, you keep it; this is a courtesy for our judges.
- 6. Only one demonstration per project.
- You may use any project already exhibited in the Lincoln County Fair. (i.e. livestock, poster, craft project, etc.)
- A maximum of 20 minutes is scheduled for a demonstration. This includes setting up, presentation, questions, answers, and clean up.
- 9. Two or more may work together to give a team demonstration.
- 10. If using a live animal, please indicate the type of animal with entry, very important for scheduling.
- 11. Small animals may be used on the stage in the Food and Craft Building.
- 12. Large animals already in livestock barns and shown as 4-H projects, may be used for a demonstration occurring in the designated outside demonstration area near the livestock barns.
- 13. A table and easel will be provided in both designated demonstration areas.
- 14. C-430 4-H demonstration evaluation will be used for judging all demonstrations.
- 15. All scores will be posted in each demonstration area as they are compiled.
- 16. Demonstrations going to State Fair must be presented at the Lincoln County Fair.
- 17. By State Fair rules: State Fair 4-H Demonstrations is for Intermediates and Seniors.
