One to four head - up to 10 points maximum . Five to nine head - up to one-half score listed . Ten head or more - full score

For this purpose, Poultry, Rabbits, Cavies, Dogs and Cats should have twice the number.

All 4-H or FFA entries in one division must be exhibited in one location.

Open Class:

Dairy, Beef, Sheep, Swine and Horses

Less than 10 head and 3 exhibitors - No Score (sow / litter, one exhibit)

Poultry, Rabbits, Dogs and Cats

Less than 20 head and three exhibitors - No Score

Llamas, mules, draft horses, miniature ponies, etc., may be substituted for Horses,

Dairy or Beef or, be considered a Special Exhibit.

Other Instructions:

Maximum of one half score for events not seen. Exhibits must be on grounds for at least 7 hours for evaluation. Contracted exhibits not to be counted but considered as a special disptay. When fair is open to the public, and advertised as such, all exhibit buildings should be open.

Outstanding features, activities, or achievements:

Open Needlework (Black & White), Clothing, Baking, Crafts, Horticulture, Photography, Floral and Grange booths.

4-H Clothing, demonstrations, horses, sheep, swine & dogs.

Problem Areas:

Lack of FFA participation - no chapter exhiibits, ag. mechanics, horticulture, few animals (only 2 Ag. teachers.)

Floor in Floral building.

Sign on Commercial building implies only Commercial, but building has Lapidary, BLM, Scouts, political booths, etc.

Tags - some areas could not tell if 4-H, Youth, Open or FFA - most good. Ribbons - small items use stick-on ribbons, not both. Trade for large Fibbons; Sundays eyening close, tagover cover by the large ribbons.

Dear Bob, Board Members & Superintendents:

Enclosed is an unoffical copy of my evaluation report for the 1993 Lincoln County Fair. I certainly enjoyed my day at your fair and all of you can feel very good for a job very well done. Congratulations on a great fair.

I think that all of my observations and recommendations are on the report, however I would like to expand on my concern about the lack of FFA and Ag teacher participation. With six high schools in the county with FFA chapters I was very disappointed to only see two teachers — one new and the other a substitute. The county fair should be the show case for Vo-Agric. departments and FFA chapters. If parents and community members can see outstanding FFA exhibits it should encourage enrollment. I suggest that you invite the teachers to a fair board meeting to discuss how to enhance FFA participation, or even some of you go to a teachers meeting.

Lack of entries, or less than 10 entries hurt the score in many areas - I realize that harvest is very late, but it is something for the Board to address for future years. Hopefully you will be able to correct the floor problem in the Floral building soon. A simple way to let people know that there are other exhibits in the commercial building would be to add a sign on the building that states "Lapidary, Scouts, etc." Some people skip commercial exhibits, but are interested in some of the other exhibits in the building.

I would not use both stick-on and large ribbons but one or the other. I suggest stick-on ribbons for small items, then the exhibitor can trade these in on Sunday evening for the large ribbon if he/she chooses to do so.
