New Business: It was brought up about the advertising for the Fair Issue of the Times. It was voted on and approved to spend the \$325. for advertising.

We need to see if we can lease a new copy machine. We have had the old one fixed but it isn't doing well. Donna and Gerry to check into that.

Pepsi has approached the fair to see if we wanted to put vending machines on the grounds. If they maintain them we get 30% of the proceeds. Gerry is to check into the matter further.

There will be horse judging on Saturday at 1PM during the fair. The Odessa FFA will provide the banners for the judging. This didn't get into the premium book.

Another matter that was brought up was how to provide shade for the goats during there show. Times conflict to use the beef arena. Ideas were brought up and will be looked into.
