

Minutes of Lincoln County Fair Advisory Board
June 21, 2002

President Gerry Stiles called meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

The first item was a presentation by T.L.C. for the Wild West Show at the fair. They gave us a run down of what they would do and what they would like us to do. A time for questions and answers. They would like the first part of their money ASAP. It was agreed to do that. They need it for their advertising.

Committee Reports: Committee's are going well. Gretchen and Ramona not present to see how their committee's are doing.

Old Business: Entertainment for the fair. It was brought up that a band had approached us that would like to perform during the fair. It is a local one. They would like \$350.00 for 2 one-hour shows. This was the Sheriff Jerry and the Wasted Rangers. This was voted on and passed. Another band is also interested, Gerry will look into that. This would be for the afternoons on the midway.

We still have a bad check for the Cuban food concession from last year. At this time it looks like we will have to write that one off, as we have not been able to collect.

Salmon BQ. The weed board does not wish to do this. Jon has found someone to do the cooking but not the serving, Jeanie had an idea of someone to do that, and will look into that.

A question was asked about the advertising for the Davenport Times, Did we want the same add as before. It was decided that we would do the same as last year.

We need to make sure all of the 2-way radios are working? When they are used for Horse Camp, they will see how many are not working and label them so we can decide what to do with them at the next meeting.

All ticket takers are in place for the fair. Thursday will be Davenport, Friday will be Reardan, Saturday will be Harrington, and Sunday will be Odessa. The Lions Clubs of the Towns will do this.

New Business: We had a bill for damage to a RV that was stored on the grounds during the winter. It was for a tarp. A motion was made and passed to pay for the damage. It was an unforeseen damage that was caused by a cat getting into the RV storage. The estimate for the damage was \$54.06. (Another RV was damaged with a window getting broken. It was voted on to replace the window.) - Lydia's

Lydia needs more information on her ribbon budget. She has a budget of \$1700.

Horse Camp rental was \$250.00.
