ProWest has asked if we could have a "pass the boot campaign" helping the injured cowboys fund. There will be more information gathered and given to Sharon for the premium book. John and Dale would like to solicit more money for the added money. It would help bring more cowboys as participants.

There was discussion about having a PeeWee rodeo on Thursday with a limit of 8-10 kids in each event. Should we raise the gate price on Thursday for the PeeWee rodeo? There will be further discussion. John took the ProWest Judging Clinic and he could judge.

The speaker stand will need to be fixed for Bob Garrett this year.

There was discussion about changing stock contractors but was decided that with the current ones, we have the McMillan kids perform (they don't charge us.)

Erica reported that Marrisa will be going to the Creston, Wilbur and Lilac Parades. Jennifer is getting supplies for the royalty. Jennifer has the sponsor flags. There is still an outstanding bill for shirts.
