A contract was presented to the fair board from Kathy Eastman representing the Lincoln County Jr. Livestock Association. The contract is to be signed each year if the all parties agree to the terms. A motion was made by Justine & 2nd by Josie to accept the contract and to be reviewed yearly. The motion passed unanimously.

There was much discussion about the budget. We did not collect as much money as in the past for winter vehicle storage. We are down \$3000.00 from the past couple of years. On the good side, if all goes well, we will be beginning the new fair season with around \$2000.00 in our account. We should **not** have to utilize registered warrants this next year.

Gerry will be contacting carnivals during the winter months to see if any are available.

A new fair theme was voted on for the 2013 fair. The choices were narrowed down to the following themes:

Sunflowers & Scarecrows (4) Blue Jeans & Country Dreams (3) Boots, Chaps & Cowboy Hats (3) Boot Scootin' Good Time (1)
